<b>Prerequisites</b> At the beginning of the course students should be familiar with the most common file management operations (create, move, copy, delete, compress, decompress etc.) and application management (open, move, window multi-tasking, alternating between sessions etc.).				
<b>Learning objectives</b> The purpose of this course is to introduce students to the use of the specific technology tools used in translating and interpreting.  Upon finishing the course the student should be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Demonstrate knowledge of specific resources used in the field of translating and interpreting.</li> <li>• Apply this knowledge in text editing in various formats and language correction at different levels.</li> <li>• Apply this knowledge to automate basic processing in translation or interpreting tasks.</li> </ul>				
<b>Competencies</b>				
<b>Assessment criteria</b> The final mark is based on an assessment of individual and group work. To be eligible for a final mark based on the weightings given below must score a minimum of 4 over 10 in all evaluable work. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Self-study follow-up test: 30%</li> <li>• Final exam: 40%</li> <li>• Group presentation assessment: 30%</li> </ul> <p><i>These categories may vary from year to year.
